A commonly asked question is, “What are Class Periods?” The District allocates class “sections” or class periods to each High School. Their allocation is based on declining enrollment, something Northgate never seems to have. These sections make up the Master Schedule of Classes available to students and the school for Administrative and State Reporting. We provide the funds to pay for six additional Academic classes to be offered at Northgate. The money we give pays the Teachers Salaries for one period. So in effect, this line item could also be put under Salaries we pay, but I felt that it directly affects the children and their academic learning.

As you can see the money you contribute is put back into the school to enrich the education our children receive. I also encourage you to contribute to the Parent Action Team (PAT), which pays for our crisis counselors, sponsors Parent Education Nights, and will host Every 15 Minutes next year. Every 15 Minutes is a successful nation-wide drunk driving awareness program. We host it every other year. Some of you may feel that you don’t want to give funds that will support the Crisis Counselors because you feel your child doesn’t need the help. Your child might not need the help, but what about the student sitting next to them? We are all in this together. Our neighborhood is not exempt from divorce, life threatening illness, depression, academic stress, alcohol and drug abuse. PAT will be asking for a voluntary \$85.00 donation. I hope that you will support the important work of the Parent Action Team and donate to them. Terrible things happen at schools everywhere. Children feel left out, neglected, abused. Crisis Counselors, on site, provide an avenue for the children at risk at our school to find the help they need. I know that \$250.00 the PFC is asking for seems like a lot, but if you break it down, it is just a little over a dollar a day. If your employer offers a Matching Fund program, you can effectively double your donation to the PFC. Many companies will allow you to submit more than one form, so you will also be able to double your support to the school as well.

The Northgate PFC will gladly accept a charge card payment for your voluntary donation to the Education Fund. We can arrange for a monthly or quarterly payment schedule. The school will accept one check for all your voluntary donations to the Departments. We also have an on-line system to pay for school and parent donations directly from your computer!

Commonly asked questions:
What do the Departments do with our donations?

Most of the money that is donated to Departments covers the cost of copying. Once that is paid for, Department use the funds to replace worn books, buy DVD players, and materials to enrich our children's educational experience.

Why are the fees for Art Classes so high?

These fees are not donations; they are the material costs for your child to take the class. Art supplies are expensive, even at the school discounted rates. If your child took an Art Class outside of school you would be required to pay a materials fee, separate from the cost of the class.

Mark your calendars! Freshman parents please attend the August 17th Parents' Night at 7pm in the gym. This evening offers a lot of important information for your next four years at Northgate.

Walkthrough registration days are August 22nd and 24th. Parents **MUST** accompany their children. See the website for more details.
