

# YOUR SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL

The purpose of this council is to promote excellence in education at Northgate by using special funds to supplement the regular program. The Northgate High School Site Council develops and recommends school improvement through the *Single Plan for Student Achievement*, coordinates and monitors all programs and funds included in the School/Library Block Grant (SLIBG). It also has on-going responsibility to review with the principal, teachers, other school personnel, parents and students the implementation of the Single Plan for Student Achievement and to assess periodically the effectiveness of the program. In addition, the School Site Council annually reviews the plan through an implementation survey, and based on that assessment, establishes a budget consistent with the Education Code, and if necessary makes modifications to the plan to reflect changing improvement needs and priorities, and take other actions as required by the Education Code.

## **MEETINGS**

Site Council meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month in the school library at 3:10 p.m. At the end of each session, a Public Comment session is held. An Agenda is posted in the Office at Northgate approximately one week prior to each meeting.
