

Dean Lesher Spring Concert Volunteer Descriptions:

Offload Equip. – On the afternoon of the Spring Concert, parent volunteers help several students unload the equipment and large instruments from the truck at the Lesher Center. Volunteers are to report to the Backstage Entrance by 3:20pm. This jobs goes very quickly if there plenty of helpers (often an hour or less).

Green Room - Volunteers stay in the Green Room where they help maintain quiet. This is the room adjacent to the stage where the students wait to go on next. The group's chaperones will be there also. There is a TV in the Green Room which shows what is happening onstage.

Band Chap. – The Band Chaperones accompany the students for one of the four groups. Chaperones are given an itinerary (detailed schedule), student checklist, and the student tickets. There are dressing rooms for warm-up, and a Green Room. If they are chaperoning Concert or Symphonic Band, they wait with them from arrival through performance and then, after stowing instruments, accompany them to the balcony to see the rest of the concert. If they are chaperoning Wind Ensemble or Orchestra, after students stow instruments, the Chaperones take them to the balcony to see the first half of the show, then accompany them to the Backstage area to begin warm-up, etc.

Backstage – Wear black. These volunteers work onstage to prepare the chairs and equipment for each group. During the performances, they stay in the wings and do not go into the audience.

Strike – These volunteers come onstage after the end of the concert and pack up the chairs and load the truck and equipment. The more help we have for Strike, the quicker everyone goes home. This job is very quick and easy if we have enough helpers! Some of the strike crew is needed to help unload the truck back at school.
