## What are matching gifts and how can I make sure my gift is matched?

Many employers will match gifts made by their employees, retirees, and directors to non-profit organizations; some even offer a higher than 1 to 1 match. To see if your company offers matching or to get a matching gift form, contact your company's human resources department. By spending a few short minutes filling out a simple form, you can often double the power of your gift.

### It's easy- here's all you need to do!

1. Your **Human Resources Department** will give you a *Matching Gift* form. Some companies even have their forms available online.
2. Fill out the **Employee** section. Please designate that the gift go to the **Northgate Parent Faculty Club**.
3. Bring it to the school office and drop it in the PFC box, OR mail it to:
